#### **Nobel Laureates**




One current and one former member of staff at the University of Nottingham were awarded Nobel Prizes in 2003.



Professor Sir Peter Mansfield was awarded the Nobel Prize for Medicine for his pioneering work on the development of NMR imaging.

Professor Clive Granger was awarded the Nobel Prize for Economics for his work on methods of analysing economic time-series with common trends (co-integration).
