Twenty graduate students, 12 in doctoral course and 8 in master's course, participated from Tohoku University, from the five sponsor programs above. Ten professors in total attended the summer school from Tohoku University More than 20 professors and 50 graduate students participated from France side. Official language was English.

Included programs were; scientific lectures by professors of ECL, INSA-Lyon and Tohoku University, presentations and following discussions by the students on the research works of themselves and those of their mother laboratories, tour of research laboratories of ECL and INSA-Lyon, lectures of French language and culture, introduction of higher education institution in France, visit of international institutes as European Organization for Nuclear Research (CERN) and World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), visit of Toray Plastics Europe S.A.S. etc. Tour of historical Lyon City Hall and also of Old Lyon City, the UNESCO World Heritage, was very interesting, too.
