Information for the short oral presentation [ATTENTION !!!]:

Due to a large number of paper submissions, all presenters have to submit presentation file (in **PDF file only**) in advance (**by October 28th**). Details are mentioned below. Please check the instructions carefully.

- All presentations should be prepared **ONLY in PDF file (Maximum 5 MB)**.
Adobe Acrobat Pro DC 2015.006.30306 will be available for use.

Deadline of the submission: October 28th, 2019

(Any submission later than the deadline cannot be accepted.)

- We will prepare a PC for the short oral presentation. You CANNOT use your PC on the short oral presentation.
- Presentation time is 2 min. Presenters are strongly advised to keep your presentation below 3 slides including the title page.
- Presentation slide size should be the 4:3 format (Slides with the 16:9 format cannot be accepted)
- All collected presentation files will be deleted by the committee after the conference.

Information for the poster presentation:

- **You CANNOT print your poster at the conference venue**, so please print the poster out before the conference by yourself.
- The poster size is necessary to be made within **1700mm in height and 900 mm in width**.
