2. Short Oral Presentation

- > The presentation time is 1 min.
- All presentations should be prepared ONLY in PDF file (1 slide, Maximum 5 MB). Please use the template which we will distribute via e-mail. Please submit your presentation's PDF file in advance via the google form by November 5th. For more details, we will announce later by e-mail.
- ➤ We will prepare a PC for the short oral presentation. The participants CANNOT use their own PCs for the short oral presentations.

3. Poster Presentation

- ➤ The presentation time is 70 min per session.
- \triangleright The poster must be printed in A0 size: 1189 mm (H) \times 841 mm (W).
- You are required to print your poster by yourself in advance, and all posters (OS 23-1 OS 23-64) should be **displayed between 1:10 p.m. 2:40 p.m. on**November 18th.

Your poster should be **removed by 12:30 p.m. on November 19**th. Posters not removed by the specified time will be disposed of by the organizers.

Best Presentation Award for Students Session

Under a strict review process, participants who give <u>exceptional presentations will be awarded</u> certificates for the "Best Presentation Award for Students Session". All presenters are eligible for the award. However, evaluation for late submissions may be considered separately.
