1. Presentation Style

The presentation style is face-to-face poster session. Speakers are asked to come to the venue on the designated presentation day and stand by the poster which summarizes their research. Then, the speakers will answer the questions as appropriate about your research from the audiences and other speakers. Posters cannot be printed at the conference venue, so speakers are required to print their posters in advance and bring them to the venue. Posters should be no longer than 1700mm (H) x 900mm (W). Posters larger than this size cannot be displayed because they cannot fit on the poster board we will prepare.

2. Short Presentation Video

We will ask speakers to record a few minutes video briefly explaining their research and submit it to us. The video will be uploaded to YouTube and shown on a large monitor at the conference venue on the day of the presentation. Details will be updated later.

3. Poster Session Schedule

OS21 is divide into the three dates. Speakers will be asked to give a presentation in one of the three sessions. A session will be divided into the first half and the second half, and speaker will have a "core time" in either time.
