Please use the built-in styles provided in the Word template < Built-In Styles: Main text>. The length of a paper should be **two to four A4-sized pages** including:

Conclusions (or Concluding Remarks)

References

Acknowledgements (if applicable)

Appendices (if applicable)

2.1 Formats < Built-In Styles: Subsection>

2.1.1 Layout< Built-In Styles: Subsubsection>

The main text is composed of **two columns**. Each column must be 8 cm width and justified. The spacing between the columns must be 1 cm. The left and right margins in a page must be 2 cm, and the top and bottom margins must be 2.5 cm.

2.1.2 Font

The manuscript should be in "Times New Roman" (or equivalent). The font size for the title should be 12 pt and all other font sizes 10 pt.

2.2 Title

The title should be bold and centered. The author's name should appear below the title and his/her affiliation and address should appear on a separate line immediately below the author's name. They are centered. Underline the speaker.

Leave one line between the title and the author's name, between the author and the abstract, and between the abstract and the main text. All other line spacings should be one line (single spaced).

2.3 Equations

Equations are numbered. The equation number should be aligned right and the same size as used in the text (10 pt).

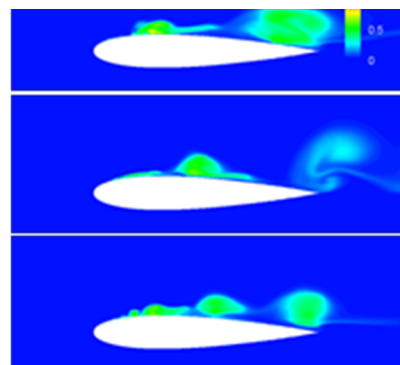


Fig. 1 Two or more line captions should be flush left under the figure. Add one line space above the figure caption (One line figure captions should be centered under the figure).

2.4 Table and Figures

Figures are reduced to fit within the margins of each column. Symbols and legends should be legible. Tables and figures should be numbered in the order in which they appear in the text. Color figures are acceptable.

2.5 References

A list of references should be included at the end of the text. References should be numbered in citation order and abbreviated in the appropriate format [1,2]. Initials should precede the author's name [3].
