- You are required to print your poster in advance and bring it with you. All posters (OS 27-1 to OS 27-64) must be displayed between 12:45 p.m. 1:30 p.m. on November 10th
- Posters should be removed between 10:30 a.m. 12:00 p.m. on November 11th.
 Any posters not removed by the specified time will be disposed of by the organizers.

Best Presentation Award for Students Session

Under a strict review process, participants who give <u>exceptional presentations will be awarded</u> certificates for the "Best Presentation Award for Students Session". All presenters

are eligible for the award.

The students who are giving presentations will also serve as judges for each other. The details are as follows:

- •The evaluation will be conducted via a Google Form. The form will be sent by email at a later date. If you are unable to access or use the form on the day of the event, please contact one of the student organizers.
- •You may evaluate up to six presentations outside of your own presentation session.
- Judges will also receive additional points based on the number of presentations they evaluate.
- •The evaluation period will end at 12:00 p.m. on November 11.
