2. Poster Presentation

- The presentation time is 90 min per segment.
- The poster must be printed in A0 size: 1189 mm (H) × 841 mm (W).
- You are required to print your poster in advance and bring it with you. All posters (OS 27-1 to OS 27-64) must be **displayed between 12:45 p.m. - 1:30 p.m. on November 10th**.
- Posters should be **removed between 10:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. on November 11th**. Any posters not removed by the specified time will be disposed of by the organizers.

Best Presentation Award for Students Session

Under a strict review process, participants who give exceptional presentations will be awarded certificates for the “Best Presentation Award for Students Session”. All presenters

are eligible for the award.
